Important Information for Parent and Carers

Thank you for your interest in our program. We have an exciting program planned but please keep in mind excursions/incursions are also subject to change due to possible inclement weather or any situation where safety is a concern. We look forward to incorporating a variety of incursions/excursions for a fun filled program!

Centre Information: Currumbin Kids Club operates during the school holidays from 6:30am – 6:00pm. Our program offers a variety of activities and experiences, all of which are designed to enhance and develop each child's skills and abilities. We want to provide every child with a safe, nurturing, and fun environment; therefore, we have a zero tolerance towards bullying. Please refer to our Bullying and Behaviour Management Policy for further information.

Fees: The daily fee for Vacation care is \$67.00 per child per day, this amount is eligible for the government's Child Care Subsidy (CSS). Additional costs associated with incursions or excursions will be added onto the daily fee. The full fee is stated on the Vacation Care Program. This amount will receive the Child Care Subsidy. Any Late fees, Non-Cancellation Fees and Ad-Hocs are not eligible for the Child Care subsidy. If you are unsure about your entitlement to the Child Care Subsidy, please contact the Family Assistance Office on 136 150.

Childcare Subsidy (CCS): Please be aware of both your <u>CCS percentage coverage and forntightly entitlement hours</u>. A session of Vacation Care equates to 11.5 hours toward your fortnightly hours. Regardless if your child attends less than the full day; CCS is applied by the session. If you run out of hours, CCS will not apply to the remainder of your bookings until the next fortnight period. If you have questions or concerns, please send an email to discuss.

Educator to Child Ratios: The National Quality Framework (NQF) sets out the minimum qualification and educator to child ratio requirements for children's education and care services. Minimum ratios also vary based on activity and whether we are on-site or away on excursion. Total daily bookings accepted is based on Educator availability and activity type to ensure safety off all children in our care.

Current Users of Currumbin Kids Club: Use the Xplor Home app to make a Booking Request. Select the day(s) and child/ren attending, and tick the All Day box and write Vacation Care in the comment box. To attend the vacation care program, you must have a booking. We will not accept walk-in arrivals. If you do not have a booking and you need your child/ren to attend a particular day, last minute, you will need to call the service during our operating hours to see if we have any cancellations or room for them. This is particularly imperative for excursion days as the buses have a limited number of seats. However, it is important for every day of vacation care.

Game Over Excursion: Prior to being considered for the Game Over Helensvale excursion, families must complete the attached waiver IN ADDITION to the standard permission form. Siblings must have individual waivers completed and on the day enclosed shoes MUST be worn in order to participate in climbing activities. Children wearing sandals/thongs/crocs will not be able to participate without enclosed footwear.

Program: Our Program has a combination of excursions and incursions as well as standard days at the centre. We ensure our program is inclusive of all children and their various abilities. All activities are accompanied by risk assessments that can be supplied upon request.

Food Information: Currumbin Kids Club will offer a nutritional breakfast (up until 8am) and afternoon tea (around 3pm). It is the parent/carer's responsibility to pack a lunchbox with morning tea, lunch, and snacks. Please ensure your child has a substantial amount of food as our program is more physical and longer than a typical school day. This lunch should consist of standard healthy foods that you would give your child on a school day i.e., food that does not require heating or kitchen preparation. Your child must also have their own clearly labelled drink bottle, especially on excursion days as water may not always be available. If your child/ren have any dietary requirements or any allergies/food sensitivity you will need to meet with the service's co-ordinator regarding risk minimisation.

Clothing: Please ensure that your child/ren bring a SunSmart hat, as we are outside a lot, and this is particularly important in maintaining a Sun Safe Centre. We have a 'No Hat, Shade Play' Policy and any child/ren without a hat will be asked to remain in undercover areas. All children must wear suitable footwear. Sneakers, runners, or any other type of closed in shoes are acceptable. You may also wish to pack an extra change of clothes (shirt, shorts, underwear, and socks) for your child/ren in the event of wet weather or other situations.

PLEASE NOTE: Children must bring their own hat; enough food for morning tea and lunch; labelled drink bottle; wear closed-in appropriate shoes; and SunSmart clothing.

The Centre will provide sunscreen - if you do not want your child/ren to be given sunscreen then you must provide your own or speak with our educators.



In this Disclaimer the following words have the following meaning:

- 1.1 **Activities** means any use of the Facilities (or any parts of them) in connection with the Services which are permitted or approved by the Company from time to time.

- 1.3 **Conditions of Entry** means the conditions of entry and ticket purchase applicable to the Facility, as displayed at the Facility or otherwise notified to me by the Company.
- 1.4 **Disclaimer** means this document.
- 1.5 Facilities/Facility includes but is not limited to:

- 4.1 that I am medically and physically fit to participate in the Activities and have not been advised otherwise by a medical practitioner;
- 4.2 I do not have, and have not had close contact with anyone who has, fever, cough, sore throat or shortness of breath, and do not have or been in close contact with anyone who has been diagnosed with or is suspected of having COVID-19;
- 4.3 that I do not suffer from any pre-existing health condition not disclosed to the Company that may impact upon my capacity to safely participate in the Activities or that may create undue risk for others. If in doubt, I agree that I will seek medical advice prior to participating in the Activities;
- 4.4 that I am not under the influence of alcohol, drugs or other substances that could impair upon my judgment or capacity to safely participate in the Activities or that may create undue risk for others; and
- 4.5 that all information given is accurate and complete, and I hereby consent and give my authority to the Company to take all steps it considers reasonably necessary to protect my welfare in the event of injury or illness, including the administration of any emergency medical treatment and ambulance transportation and I agree to pay for any such costs.

5. ASSUMPTION OF RISK

5.1 I have assessed the nature of the Activities carefully and voluntarily assume all of the risks associated with the Activities, and I do so of my own free will. I acknowledge that if I do not wish to be exposed to such risks, then I should not participate in the Activities.

6. EXCLUSION OF LIABILITY

- 6.1 Subject to clause 7.3, I hereby agree that each of the Company and the owner of the Premises (to the extent that each of them is providing Recreational Services as defined in the CCA) will not be liable for my:
 - 6.1.1 death; or
 - 6.1.2 physical or mental injury (including the aggravation, acceleration or recurrence of such an injury); or
 - 6.1.3 contraction, aggravation or acceleration of a disease; or
 - 6.1.4 suffering the coming into existence of, aggravation of, acceleration of or recurrence of any other condition, circumstance, occurrence, activity, form of behavior, course of conduct or state of affairs that is or may be harmful or disadvantageous to me or the community, or that may result in harm or disadvantage to me or the community,

howsoever arising from my participation in the Activities, including because of negligence, breach of contract, statute or statutory duty or otherwise.

6.2 Without limiting the above, to the extent that liability cannot be excluded but can be limited, then, to the maximum extent permitted by law, the liability of the Company in connection with the Services (including the Activities) is limited to (a) the supply of the Services again, or (b) payment of an amount equal to the cost of having the Services supplied again. Further, to the extent permitted at law, I agree that the Company will not be liable for any consequential, indirect, incidental or special damages, arising out of or in connection with my participation in the Activities.

7. WAIVER OF RIGHT TO SUE AND INDEMNITY

- 7.1 Subject to clause 7.3. I hereby agree:
 - 7.1.1 not to pursue claims against any of the Indemnified Parties; and
 - 7.1.2 to hold harmless, indemnify and keep indemnified each of the Indemnified Parties from and against any and all losses, actions, expenses, costs, liabilities, claims and demands ("Claims") which may be incurred or sustained by any of the Indemnified Parties,

in connection with:

7.1.3 my death, or any physical or mental injury or any other matters identified in clause 6.1.1 to 6.1.4 (inclusive) suffered by me,

howsoever arising from my participation in the Activities or my attendance at the Premises, including whether arising because of negligence, breach of contract, statute or statutory duty or otherwise.

- 7.2 I further agree that, to the maximum extent permitted by law, none of the Indemnified Parties make any representation or warranty, implied or express, whether by statute, common law or otherwise, as to any matter including without limitation that the Services will be provided with due care and skill or that the Facilities (or any parts of them) provided in connection with the Services will be fit for the purpose for which they are used.
- 7.3 However, I understand that nothing in this Disclaimer excludes, restricts or modifies any rights that I may have as a result of a significant personal injury that is caused by the Reckless Conduct (as defined under the CCA) of the Company.

8. GENERAL

- 8.1 The foregoing exclusions and limitations apply to the fullest extent permitted at law, and if any portion hereof is held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect the enforceability of any other part or provisions of this Disclaimer.
- This Disclaimer is additional to, rather than replacement of, the conditions contained in the Conditions of Entry. To the extent that there is any inconsistency between the conditions of this Disclaimer and those contained in the Conditions of Entry, this Disclaimer shall apply.
- 8.3 The personal information I have provided to the Company enables and facilitates its delivery of the Services and (subject to the terms of my registration) enables the Company to send information relevant to the Activities. The personal information that I have provided to the Company will not be used for any other purpose without my consent.
- 8.4 The terms of this Disclaimer and its interpretation will be governed by the law of the Jurisdiction and the parties submit to the jurisdiction of the courts of the Jurisdiction.
- 8.5 To the extent necessary to enable either the owner of the Premises or any other Indemnified Parties to take the benefit of the provisions in this Disclaimer (including without limitation clauses 6 and 7 as applicable), the Company holds the benefit of the provisions on trust for those parties.
- The Company may refuse to supply any particular Services (including by not permitting me to undertake the Activities) at any time prior to my receiving those Services (including by participating in the Activities), and in that case, the Company will provide a refund of any fees already paid for those Services.
- 8.7 The Indemnified Parties (other than the Company) are intended third party beneficiaries of this Disclaimer, and to the extent necessary to give effect to that intention, the Company holds the benefit of this Disclaimer on trust for them.
